Philatelic history:

Aug 16, 1886: Imperial German Postal Agency opened in Shanghai.

Mar 1, 1898: German stamps overprinted "China".

Oct 1, 1905: Issue valued in cents and dollars.

Mar 17, 1917: Post offices closed
