German East Africa

Area: 384,180 square miles

Population: 7,680,000 c.1913

Capital: Dar-es-Salaam

Location: German colony on the east coast of Africa.

Standard Coin:

1893-1905 1 Rupee = 64 Pesa

1905-1916 1 Rupee = 100 Heller

Philatelic history:

1886 - German sphere of influence was recognized by major powers.

1888-1893 Stamps of Germany used in the colony.

1893 - German stamps overprinted with values in Pesa, for use in the colony.

1916 - Stamps of Tanganyika, Ruanda ~ Urundi and Kionga (Lourenzo Marques) were issued following Allied victories during World War I.
