Government: Military control divided into four zones (British, American, French and Russian)

Standard Coin: 100 Pfennige = 1 Mark

Philatelic history:

Mar. 19, 1945 - Allied Military Post Stamps used in Aachen.

Dec. 17, 1945 - First French zone issues.

Jun. 9, 1945 - First Russian zone issues.
